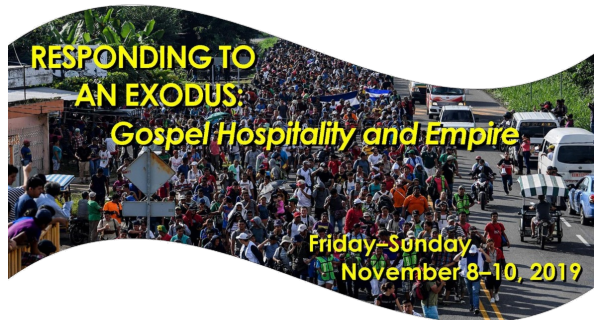
DONATE ITEMS FOR CHURCH CLASSROOMS

Honduras Mission Trip January 16th 25th, 2020

Each year Orangewood PC organizes a work trip in the western mountains of Honduras. We stay at a hotel in Copan Ruinas and go out to nearby communities each day to help build houses, hold medical clinics, and interview students for scholarships to attend school beyond the 6th grade. We welcome everyone to join us in this meaningful experience. Tim Wheeler, a retired mission co-worker, accompanies us on the trip and several in the group are fluent in Spanish but this is not a requirement! This work is based on Tim and Gloria Wheeler's values-based development philosophy. It is amazing to see it in action! This trip is demanding in terms of climbing hills in uneven terrain, riding in a bus on bumpy roads, and eating unfamiliar food – “moderate” in hiking terms. The coordinator takes every precaution for our safety and well-being and the fellowship of the group is tremendous.
